

Gábor Bojár

Gábor Bojár earned a degree in physics at the Geophysics Institute Eötvös Lóránd in 1973. Under his leadership Graphisoft, a software development company focusing on 3D architectural design became one of the top three software vendors of the sector internationally. Its leading product, ArchiCAD® is used by more than 200,000 architects worldwide. Graphisoft had been introduced to the Frankfurt (1998) and the Budapest (2000) stock exchange. In 2007 it was purchased by the German Nemetschek AG company. Mr. Bojár was distinguished by numerous national and international awards such as the Széchenyi prize, the Order of Merit of the Hungarian Republic, the Ernst and Young Entrepreneur of the Year Award in Hungary, and he was invited speaker several times at the Davos World Economic Forum.

In 2006, Graphisoft's software development and its real estate operations split into two separate companies; Mr. Bojár is Chairman of the Board of both companies (Graphisoft SE and Graphisoft Park SE). At present, he is working on founding a globally competitive institute of higher education specializing in information technology and biotechnology.
